SEMO Food Bank receives \$5,000 from BNSF for food distribution programs in Chaffee

CHAFFEE, MO (July 12, 2021) – Southeast Missouri Food Bank was awarded a \$5,000 grant from BNSF Railway Foundation to fund food distributions in Chaffee.

"Strong community relationships are so important in fighting hunger," said Joey Keys, chief executive officer of the food bank. "BNSF has a long history with Chaffee, and their support will help so many people in the community who do not have enough food."

One in six households and one in five children in Chaffee are considered food insecure. The programs funded by BNSF Foundation will help address those needs with quarterly mobile food distributions. Each mobile food pantry provides at least 200 families with about 30 pounds of nutritious food.

The grant will also sponsor six Chaffee students in the Backpacks for Friday program for the 2021-2022 school year. Children in the program take home a pack of food each week of the school year, providing healthy, no-prep meals for the weekend.
