Each of the six food banks— Harvesters Community Food Network, Ozarks Food Harvest, St. Louis Area Foodbank, Southeast Missouri Food Bank and The Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri—will receive \$10,000 to purchase food in the upcoming months. "With this donation, Feeding Missouri's food banks can provide over 240,000 meals to neighbors in Missouri who struggle to find food," noted Kenney.

Partnerships like these are paramount and make it possible for food banks to be there for families facing uncertain times. We are so thankful that State Farm is using "Good Neighbor Day" to play a role in strengthening their communities across the state.
